The figures in Set #1 conform with the candidate percentages released by the National Electoral Commission (NEC). The figures in Set #2 are sometimes used, although the number of votes received by some of the candidates varies, in a few cases significantly. The percentages based on the total number of valid votes in Set #2 is rarely used by any source. After a further review of both sets of figures, the results from Set #1 are the most reliable and now appear on the African Elections Database website.
